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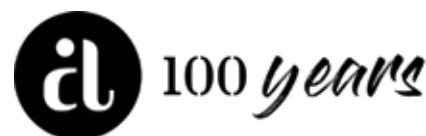
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# Kevin's Quilt

## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** From each of the (22) fabrics cut (4) 3 3/8" squares and (7) 2 7/8" squares. Cut the 2 7/8" squares across (1) diagonal to make a total of (322) 2 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric B** Cut (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (40) 2 1/2" squares.

**Fabric C** Cut (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1" x 57" strips.  
Cut (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1" x 58" strips.  
Cut (1) 3 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 3/8" squares and (7) 2 7/8" squares. Cut the 2 7/8" squares across (1) diagonal to make (14) 2 7/8" triangles. *Use these pieces with Fabric A pieces.*

**Fabric D** Cut (2) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (5) 8 1/2" squares.

**Fabric E** Cut (1) 12 5/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 12 5/8" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (12) side setting triangles.  
Cut (1) 6 5/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 6 5/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) corner setting triangles.

<b>Backing</b>	4 1/2 yards	9853-KR

**Fabric F** Cut (16) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (64) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

**Fabric G** Cut (4) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 68" strips.  
Cut (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 58" strips.

**Binding** Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

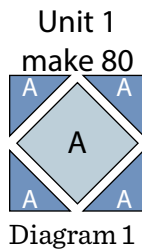
**Backing** Cut (2) 76" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 76" x 76" backing.

# Kevin's Quilt

## Making the Quilt

### 1. Block Assembly

Select (4) matching  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric A triangles. Sew (1)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric A triangle to each of the (4) sides of (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Diagram 1). The unit should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (80) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Sew together (4) Unit 1 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) Block One square (Diagram 2). The block should measure  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (20) Block One squares total.



### Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square to each end of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip. Sew (1) Fabric E corner setting triangle to the top of the newly sewn strip to make Row One (Diagram 3).
- Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of (1) Block One square. Sew (1) Fabric E side setting triangle to each end of the newly sewn strip to make Row Two (Diagram 3).
- Sew together (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B squares and (3)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strips, alternating them from left to right to make Row Three (Diagram 3).
- Refer to Diagram 3 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Four through Row Fifteen.
- Sew together the (15) Rows, in numerical order from top to bottom, to make (1) Unit 2 block (Diagram 3).

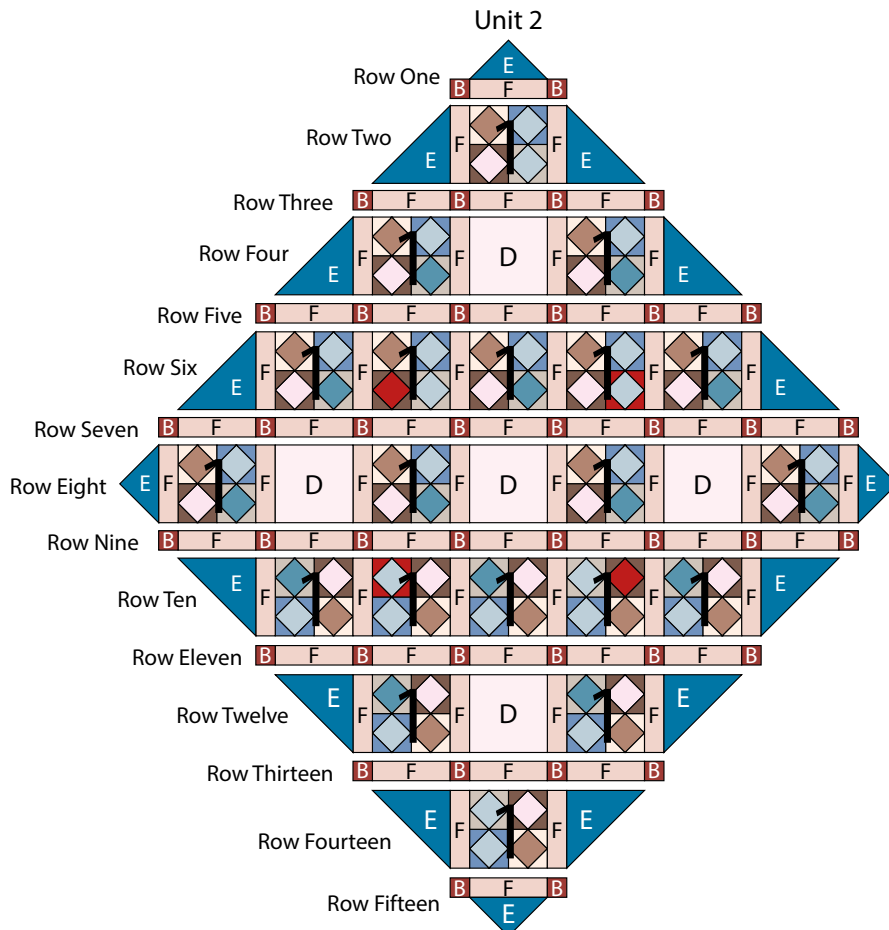

# Kevin's Quilt

- Trim the Unit 2 block to measure 57" x 57" to make the Center Block (Diagram 4).

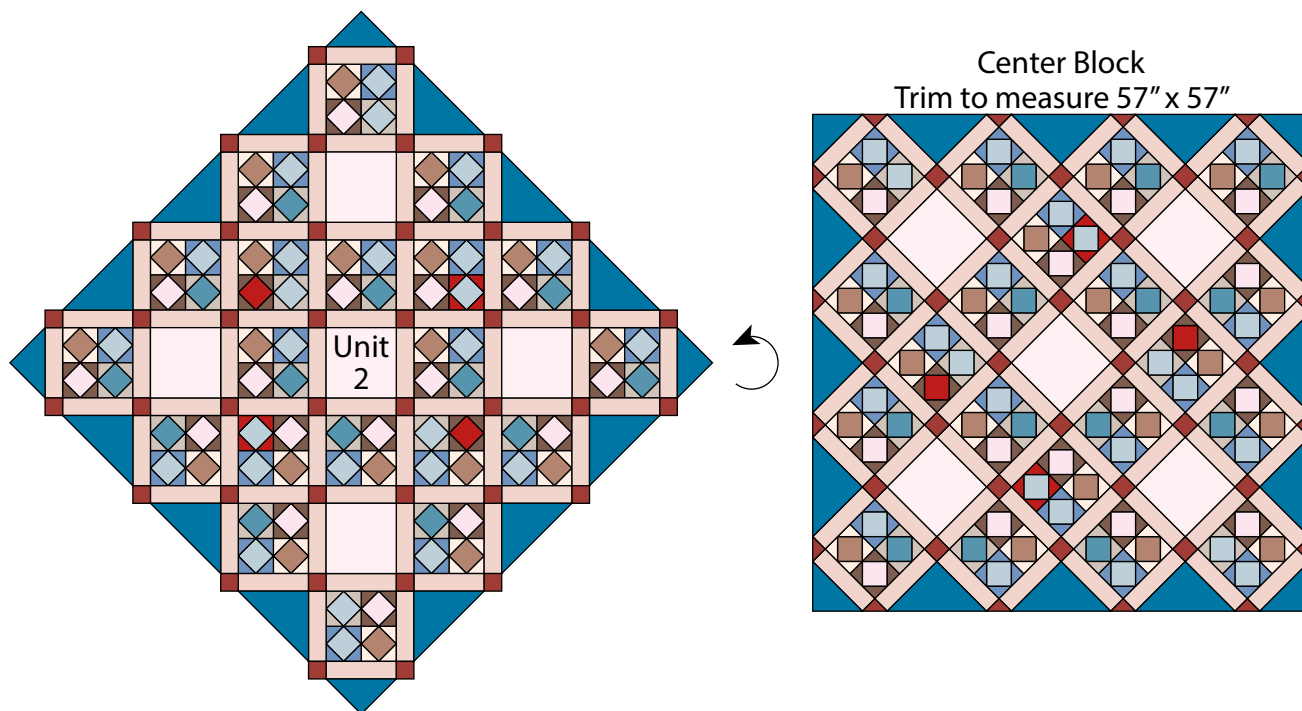
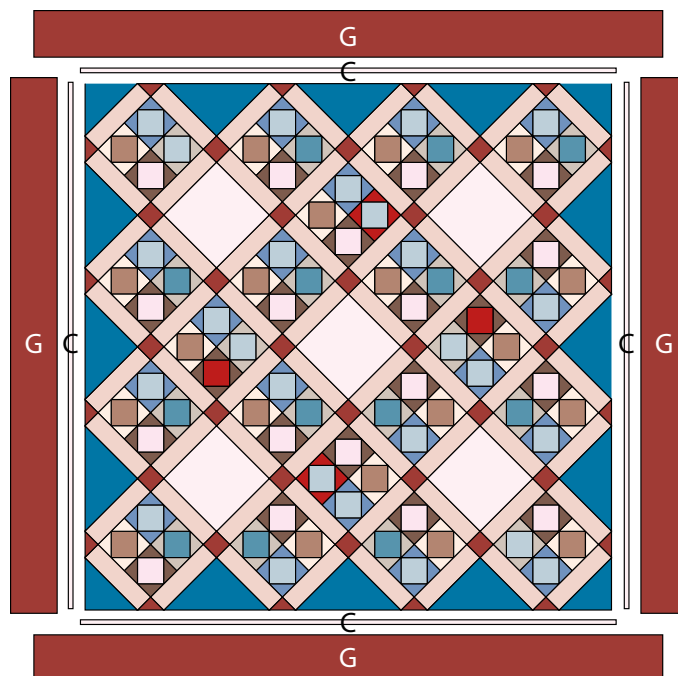

- Sew (1) 1" X 57" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1" x 58" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 58" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 68" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew the (7) binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.

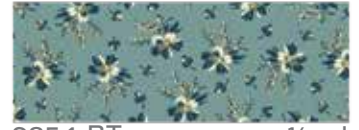
